FILM TACKLING WHITE SUPREMACY, POLICE SHOOTINGS AND BLACK MILLENIALS TO SCREEN IN MINNEAPOLIS

Harstco Moving Pictures will hold a public screening of the film *The Education of a Negro* on Saturday November 2nd in Minneapolis at the Saint Anthony Main Theater.

Set against the backdrop of the fictional Twin Cities Police Department, the film explores the depths a young couple will go to in order to get justice for a murdered loved one, and the terrifying lengths the white supremacists killers will take to cover it up.

The film was written and directed by Minneapolis North High graduate Ryan Culver (1998), who began penning the screenplay the day after the Philando Castile murder trial ended.

“[Jon] Tevlin’s Strib article about the ‘fault of circumstances’ was the exact type of media-rationalizing that was used for 150 years to normalize race violence against blacks. I wanted to counter.”

The Education of a Negro is big and bold in both talent and scope. Shot in Los Angeles over 22 days, it includes 50 actors and has already been accepted into a few film festivals including The Twin Cities Film Fest (TCFF) where it will have its Minnesota premiere Monday October 21st. Both the TCFF premiere and Saint Anthony screenings will include a Q&A with the director at the conclusion of the film.
